



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Projects which do not comply with these conditions and rules will be disqualified.

- All exhibitors must submit an entry form by the latest 5.00pm on Friday 24th August 2018 (unless prior arrangement is made).
- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor(s) only, however advice may be sought from any source and special components (e.g. transformers and glassware) may be purchased. The major construction must be the work of the exhibitor(s).
- Exhibitors must prepare their exhibit on a stand as a complete, self-contained unit. No parts may be attached to tables, walls or floor. The base of the exhibit must not exceed 1.2 x 0.75 metres.
- Students attend on Tuesday 25th September at the Trafalgar Centre
 - register between 8.30am and 9.00am
 - install their exhibit by the latest 10.00am
 - be present for judging interviews between 10.00am and 3pm.
- It is recommended that exhibitors bring a packed lunch, reading material or homework for the day. Interview times will be provided at registration
- Each exhibit must be labelled by the competitor with the competition number and the brief description title (as on the entry form). A brief explanation of the objective of the project is to be attached in a prominent place. This should also state which part of the exhibit or of the work done was completed by someone other than the exhibitor(s) or was purchased.
- Exhibitors are requested to check carefully not only their spelling, but also the accuracy of their statements. Both types of error will be taken into account by the Judges.
- All explanations should be in bold lettering, legible from 2 metres away. (Competition numbers will be supplied at the Fair).
- An exhibit that has been awarded a prize may not be re-entered in any subsequent Science Fair.
- Prizes and awards will be announced at the prize giving event.
- Competitors must abide by the rules of the competition
