

## RECOGNITION OF PRIOR ACTIVITY (RPA) – SCOUTING NEW ZEALAND

There are two areas of RPA that Scouts can apply for:

- 1 RPA of up to three months can be used for your major section of the Award. Only activity achieved in the previous 12 months can count towards RPA.
- 2 RPA for the Adventurous Journey – **Training section only** for the first level of the Award that you sign up for.

RPA must be agreed with your Award Leader when the participant first registers for the Award. **It will not be applied retrospectively.** You can only claim RPA for the first Award you sign up to – this would be either your Bronze Award, Direct Entrant Silver Award or Direct Entrant Gold Award.

To gain RPA, you must:

1. complete this form and upload it to your Online Record Book in the Award section where you are requesting RPA.
2. When you have completed your entire Award, email: [admin@dofehillary.org.nz](mailto:admin@dofehillary.org.nz) to claim to RPA.
