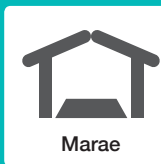

The marae (meeting ground) is the focal point of Maori communities throughout New Zealand. Most marae are iwi-based (tribal). Some urban community marae are pan-tribal.

Visitors are welcome to stop and take a look from the outside, but cannot walk on to the marae without being formally welcomed by the people of that place.

Visitors must remove their shoes before entering the marae and not eat food or drink inside. Always seek permission before taking photos.
