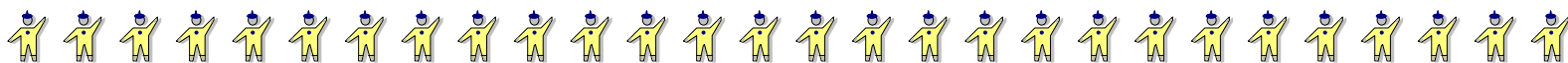
It was good news to hear that we have already raised \$2,500 for the Neo-natal

JULY MEETING - RAEWYN SUTTON - CANCER SOCIETY

Raewyn Sutton kindly filled in at the last minute for Tracey Harris who was sick. Raewyn is the Health Promotion Manager for the Cancer Society and she has obviously done this before. She gave a very interesting talk on all aspects of her involvement with the Cancer Society. She talked about the high rates of cancer in New Zealand especially bowel and skin cancers. She reminded us to have regular checks, eat healthily, limit alcohol and cover up in the sun, avoiding the hottest part of the day if possible. She advised that we do not need to go to factor 50 sunblock (it has more chemicals) as factor 30 is quite adequate. The Cancer Society have 6 divisions in New Zealand which help support not only cancer patients but also their families, helping them to improve the life of the terminally ill patients.

Raewyn thanked us for our silky pillows and wheatbags which many of our members have made over the years. The patients are most appreciative of the comfort they get from those. She also brought along some beannies and bra inserts for breast cancer patients and will forward on those patterns for those interested.

WOW TICKETS - We have sold most of the tickets for the preview of the WOW and have raised \$2,500 for the Neonatal Unit.

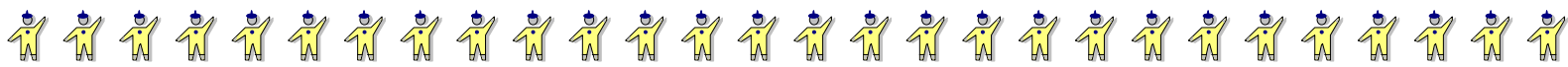
ENTERTAINMENT BOOK

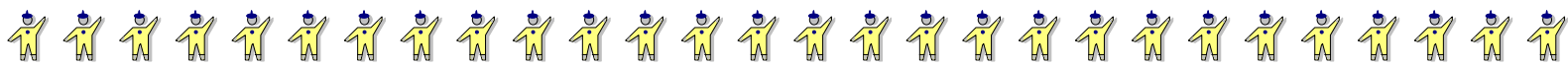
