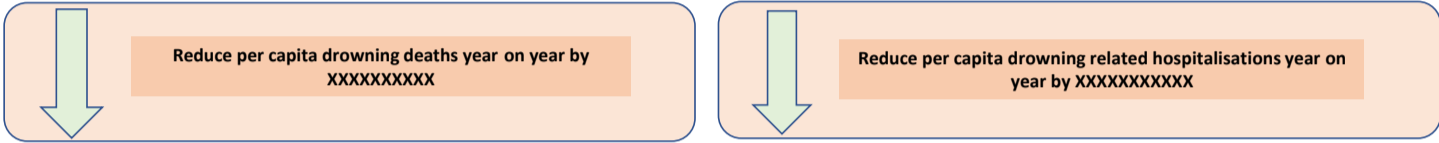


# DRAFT NEW ZEALAND WATER SAFETY SECTOR STRATEGY 2021-2025

**VISION: We envisage a future where no one drowns in Aotearoa, New Zealand**

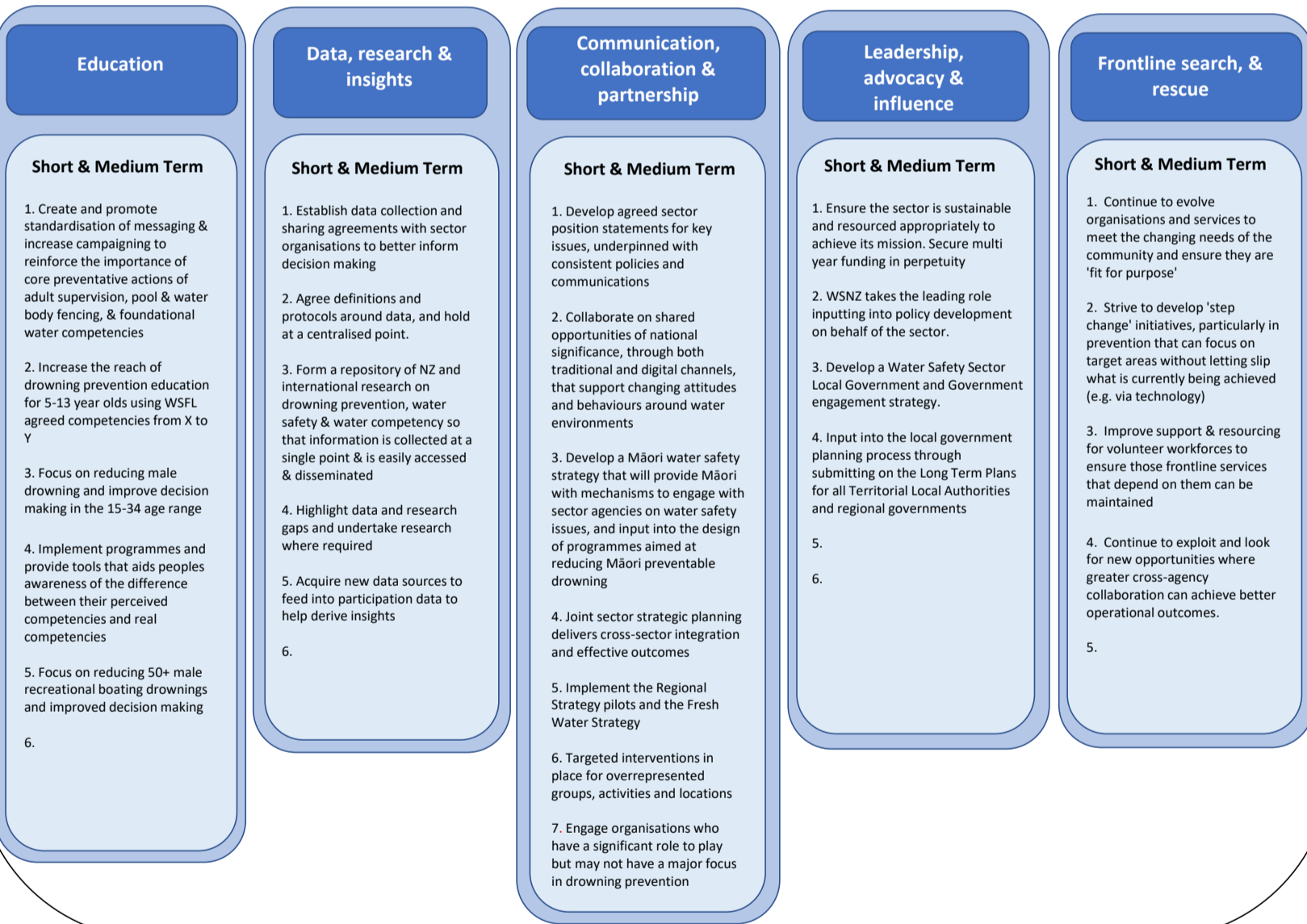
**MISSION: To work collectively to reduce drowning and water related injuries in Aotearoa, New Zealand, so all enjoy the water safely**

## IMPLEMENTATION PLAN, MONITORING AND EVALUATION

The **implementation plan** will move the strategic sector plan into action. It will identify the above stated objectives, lists the project tasks, defines roles and responsibilities, outline the budget and required resources, and lists any assumptions

Engage an implementation manager with oversight of the sector strategy

Form technical working groups tasked with creating high impact actions to reduce drowning and/or promote water safety against each of the steps in the action plan

Develop a water safety sector implementation plan

A sector **wide monitoring and evaluation framework** will gauge progress, effectiveness and efficiency of the water safety sector, generating the expected outcomes. It will ensure activities undertaken move the sector closer to delivering on the stated outcomes

The monitoring and evaluation framework will enable the sector to measure and report on the expected outcomes effectively and efficiently each year. This will fulfil the statement of service performance reporting obligations with the sectors funders, and the individual organisations evaluation of their involvement working towards the sectors strategic areas of focus
